LPX Finish on DLW Linoleum

Our new LPX finish is a surface layer applied at the factory to protect the linoleum from dirt and marks. No additional treatment is basically required for DLW LPX Linoleum if our recommendations for cleaning and maintenance are followed.

Composition

- Safe water-based plastic dispersion
- The basis is an environmentally-compatible polyacrylate, as normally used as the initial treatment for resilient floor coverings.
- Applied in two layers / work steps and heat-cured.

Technical properties

- High wear resistance
- High resistance to marking by shoes/heels
- Non-slip (R9)
- Safe as non-toxic when burning
- Maintaining of anti-bacterial properties of linoleum
- Permeable, breathable

Benefits

- No initial treatment basically required
- Thus saving work time
- Also saving detergents and costs of treatment
- Appearance of floor covering remains constantly good throughout its service life.
- Restoration / repair easily possible in case of damaging
- Low tendency to soiling
- Simple cleaning and maintenance, see our recommendation for DLW LPX Linoleum
